Driving Directions:

The Pueblo Convention Center - located just West of I-25 and the First Street exit (98B) at 320 Central Main Street, Pueblo, CO 81003 (corner of First Street and Main Street).

Grace and St. Stephen’s Episcopal Church (*Convention Eucharist, Thursday, October 1st, 7:00pm*)
601 North Tejon Street, Colorado Springs, CO, 80903

- Heading south on I-25; Take West Uintah Street exit (143); head east on Uintah Street; turn south (right) on to North Nevada Street; turn west (right) on to East Monument Street for one block.
- Heading north on I-25; Take West Bijou Street exit (142); head east on Bijou Street (turns into Kiowa Street); turn north (left) on to North Tejon Street; continue five and a half blocks.

Parking: There is limited parking in, and around, Grace and St. Stephen’s Episcopal Church. It is primarily street parking and watch that some of the parking is metered and you may need to pay (*depending on where and at what time you arrive*).
